# The First Verses

Angel Jibrael عليه السلام gave the **first five verses** of the Qur'an to Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم in cave Hira.

Cave Hira is on Mount Noor in Makkah

The first word the Angel Jibrael said was "Iqra!" which means read.

Prophet Muhammad صلى الله عليه وسلم was 40 years old when Angel Jibrael came to him with the verses and told him he was a prophet of Allah.

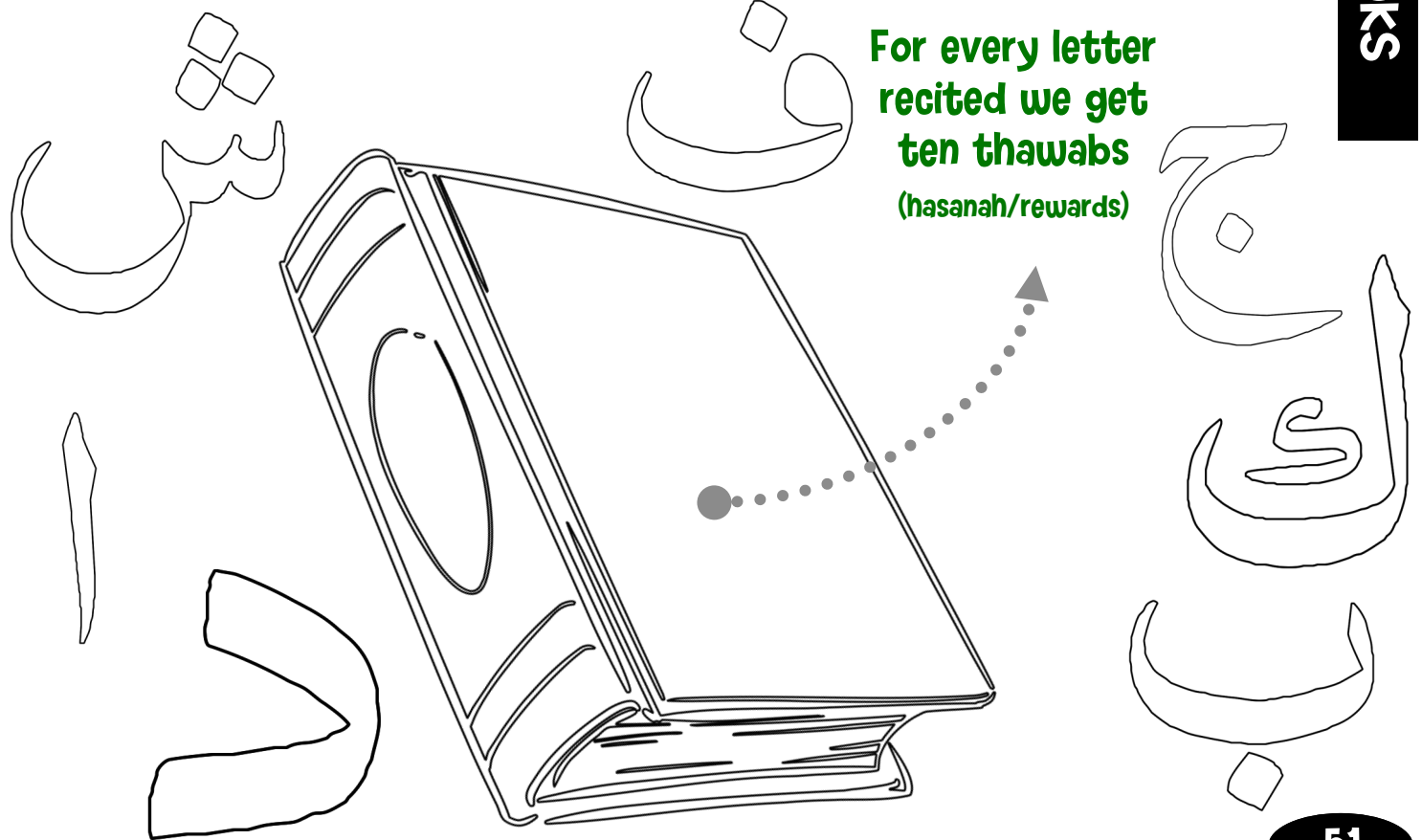
The Arabic language was at its best at the time of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. The Arabs were experts in the language.

For every letter recited we get ten thawabs (hasanah/rewards)

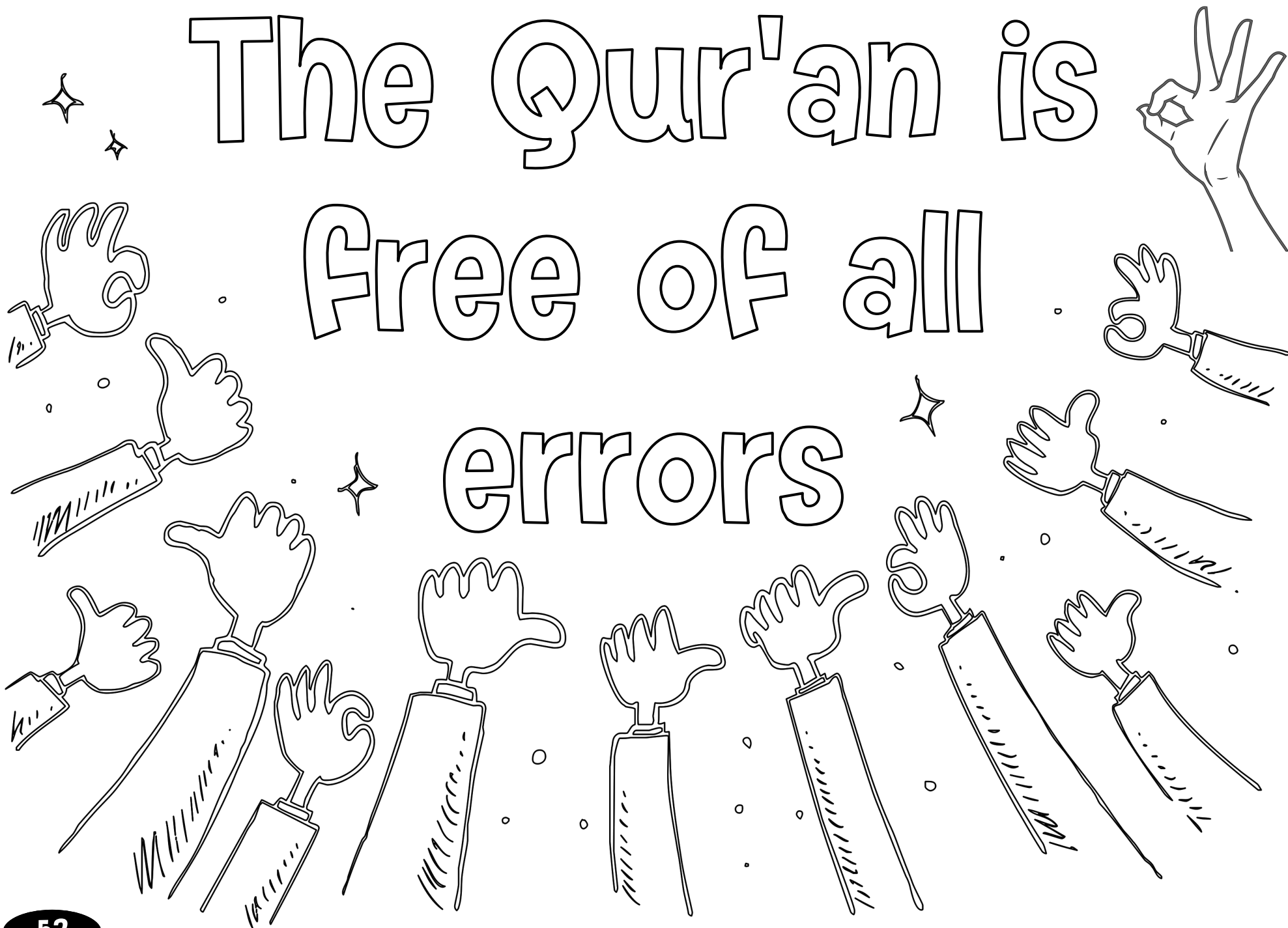

The Qur'an tells us about the future which has been entirely accurate. This shows us that the information is from Allah alone. Other people have made predictions and prophecies that have been vague and often wrong.

# Story Time

The people were so surprised. I would say they were actually shocked. Prophet Muhammad ﷺ recited some words, and these were eloquent and beautiful. More incredible than anyone had ever heard before!

This man, Muhammad ﷺ, who had never recited a word of poetry before, said that they were the words of Allah.

This man, Muhammad ﷺ, was 'unlettered' and couldn't read or write. There were no schools in those days, and very few people

could read or write.

Where could he possibly get these verses? The Arabs loved Arabic and were indeed the experts in their language. They knew that this was far superior to anything they had heard before in their entire history.

They called Walid ibn Mughirah one of their leaders. He was one of the best poets and so well educated. He knew all types of Arabic poetry and was a genius poet himself.

He was so good that often, they would hang his poems inside the Ka'bah. Only the absolute best poems were put in the Kab'ah.

Walid was told to go and listen to Prophet

Muhammad ﷺ and tell them where he got such masterpieces of words from.

Walid went to listen to the Qur'an from Prophet Muhammad ﷺ as the Makkans waited patiently outside.

Walid listened to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ recite the Qur'an and was amazed to his very core. It was so beautiful; his heart brimmed with joy. He was at a loss for words as he listened to these beautiful verses.

He finally left the company of Prophet Muhammad ﷺ but walked right past the Makkans and into his own house. He ignored everyone around him and never came back outside. He couldn't

find the words to express what he had heard and experienced.

The people waited and waited until finally, they went into his house. They hassled him to tell them about the Qur'an. Where did Prophet Muhammad ﷺ get these verses from?

Walid said that these words were not the words of a man. They were not of this world. A human could never compose such verses!

The people loved the Qur'an and knew it was from Allah. Many people became Muslims listening to the Qur'an.

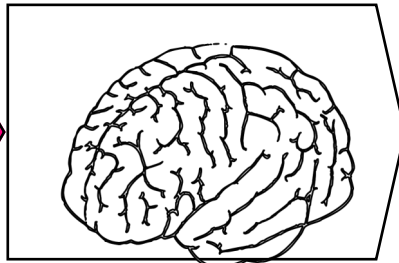
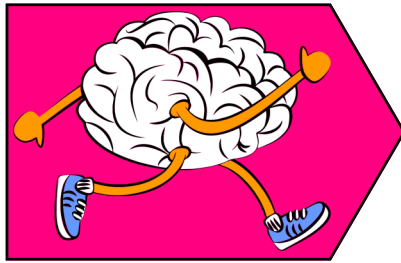
Even the enemies of Islam would secretly listen to the Qur'an being recited!

No one to this day has been able to produce even a chapter like that of the Qur'an, but still in awe at the recitation to this day.

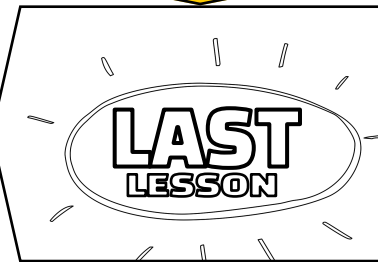

# Writing Down the Qu'ran

The verses of the Qur'an were revealed to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ and then written down by the Scribes.

The scribes wrote it down and read it back to Prophet Muhammad ﷺ.

This way they were double checked as well.

The scribes wrote it on rocks, bark from trees, large bones, animal skins..

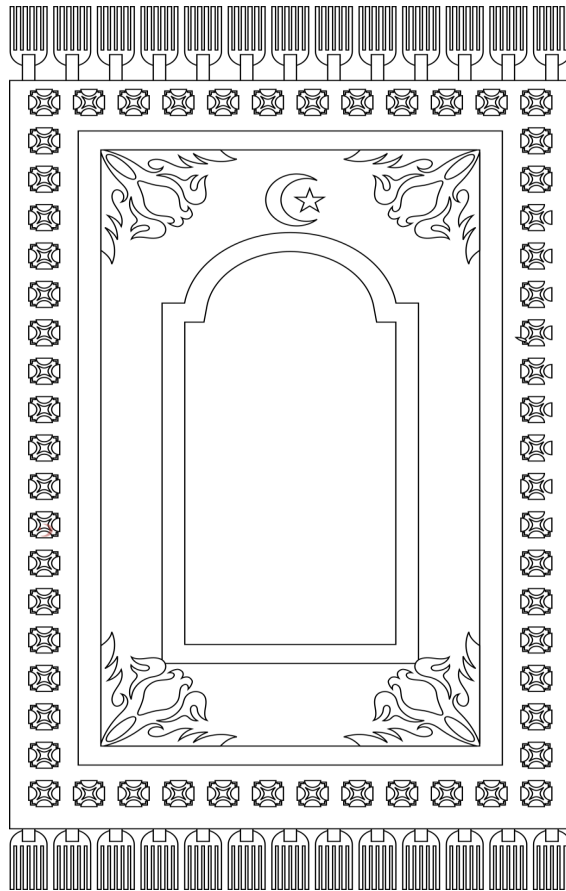
Paper was not easily accessible in those days.

Not many people could read and write.

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ was also 'unlettered'.

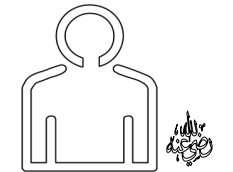


After Prophet Muhammad ﷺ passed away, the written verses were collected and put together in one collection.

# Spreading the Qur'an

The third Khalifah sent copies of the Qur'an and Huffaz to teach the people in far away Muslim lands.

Asked Zayd bin Tabit رضي الله عنه and other huffaz to collect Qur'an.

All the Sahabah رضي الله عنهم checked and agreed there were no mistakes.

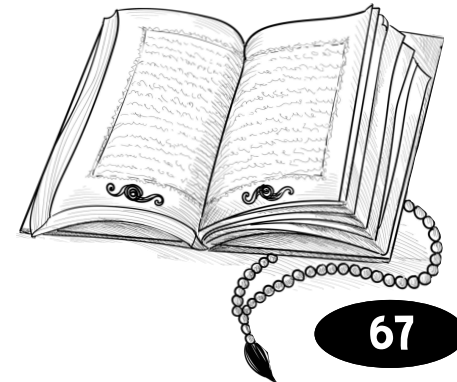
They made copies of the Qur'an and sent them throughout the Muslim empire.

The Huffaz were sent with the copies to teach the people.

# Preserving it!

1

The scholars wrote down the **meanings** of the words and different phrases used in the Qur'an. They also wrote the rules of grammar.



2

The scholars wrote down the **explanation** of the Qur'an as the Prophet Muhammad ﷺ taught it and when the verses were revealed.



3

The scholars wrote down the rules of how to **pronounce** the Qur'an properly. This is known as Tajweed.



4

The scholars wrote the dots, i'rab (zabr, zeyr, pesh | Fatha, Dhamma, Kasra etc) so that people could **read** without knowing Arabic in depth.

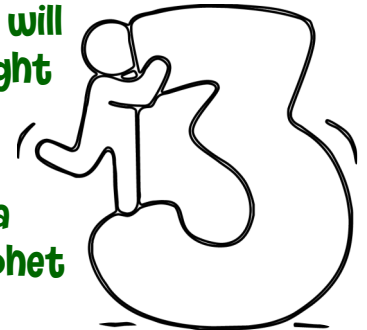
There are many people that claim to be prophets after Prophet Muhammad ﷺ. These people have all been fake prophets.

We must be careful to avoid all these false prophets because they will always lead towards Jahannam.



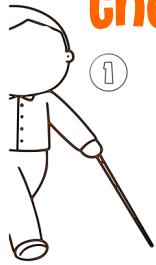
