
As soon as you reach puberty, the Hajj is fard upon you.









Huzayfah was a Sahabi who was known as the 'keeper of secrets'. He was asked about the start of the fitna.

He said the death of Umar was when it would start.

Lack of Morals

People will leave natural shame and modesty

MORALS

(haya). This can be seen with the level of indecency, corruption and evil on the earth.

Especially with social media and its reach into every part of life.



People are more dishonest with frequent breaches of trust.

People have lost their natural shame and haya. The images people share that are seen by non-mahrams demonstrates this trend.

Family Ties

Family ties are broken and children disrespect their parents. In this day and age, this is common and is increasing as time goes by.

Parents are not respected and often treated like servants.

Materialism

People have become more materialistic and self-centred. People put themselves before other people - their needs and rights.

This selfishness and self-centredness is now the norm.

Oppression

People are more oppressive throughout the world. In fact, whole nations are subjugated by huge debts, which further cripples their economies and brings misery to their people.

Usury & Interest

This is so widespread it's getting more and more difficult to protect oneself in any part of their life.

This is explicitly Forbidden in Islam.



Entertainment

Music, singing and dancing will be common amongst the people. This can be seen in all aspects of our lives.

Through social media, it reaches even the youngest and most vulnerable.

Tall Buildings

The barefooted Bedouins will compete to build the tallest buildings.

This can be seen in the Middle East, where the descendants of recent Bedouins compete to construct huge buildings.

The Dajjal (or false prophet) will be a person of incredible power that Allah has granted him. He will mislead the people and spread evil.

This will be a time of great turmoil and confusion.






We know Alah through His 99 Names (or Attributes)

Allah is Al-Qadeer (the All-Powerful), which means Allah has all the power and gives it to whoever He pleases. Nothing can happen unless Allah allows it.







Book of Deeds


On the Day of Judgement, our deeds will be given to us in a book. This is referred to as "our Book of Deeds."






