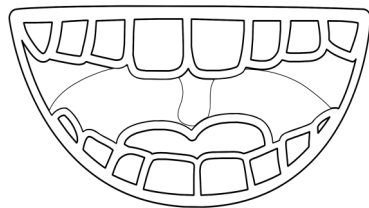

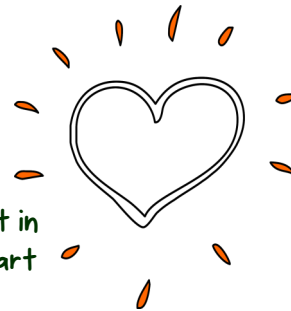

When we raise our hands and say Allahu Akbar we symbolise that we are putting the whole world and everything that it contains behind us.

We are standing in front of Allah and we are surrendering our selves to Him.

When we understand this, it will help us concentrate in Salah and our salah will have a positive effect

on us.

When we say Allahu Akbar we acknowledge that Allah is the Greatest. He is greater than the trees, mountains and oceans. He is greater than our desires. He is greater than all of creation.

When we understand that Allah is the Greatest we will know that we are nothing in front of Allah. We will begin our salah with complete humility and we will perform our salah as a slave should worship his master.

MY USTAAD SAYS:

Before we recite the Qur'an we should seek Allah's protection from the Shaytan and we should begin with Bismillah. This is why we recite Ta'awwuz and Tasmiyah before reciting Surah Fatihah in Salah.



When reciting the Qur'an in Salah we should make sure that we recite the Qur'an clearly with tajweed. We should not rush our recitation but should make sure every word is pronounced correctly.



When we are not in Salah and are reciting the Qur'an it is also mustahab to make sure we have Wudhu;

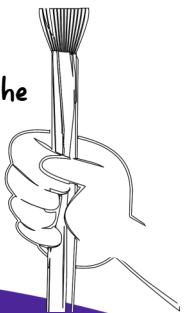


we face the Qibla and sit in a respectful way. (to touch the Quran, we must have Wudhu).

We should show respect to the Qur'an and avoid having our back towards the Qur'an or avoid

facing our feet towards the Qur'an. We should not put other books on the Qur'an nor should we put the Qur'an on the floor.

Instead, we should put the Qur'an somewhere high. We should also use the miswak before reciting the Qur'an.

MY USTAAD SAYS:

The word Subhan means that Allah is free from any evil, wrongdoing, deficiency, shortcoming, or inappropriateness; instead, Allah is perfect in every way.

This word is so powerful that it is the first zikr we do when we do tasbih such as the tasbih fatimi.

When we see anything beautiful or amazing, we say, Subhan Allah. This shows that Allah's perfection is way beyond anything else that exists.

Instead, the thing that we are looking at only seems beautiful or amazing because Allah made it that way.

In Salah, we bow down in ruku and say subhana rabbiyal azeem (and in sajdah we say subhana rabbiyal a'ala) acknowledging Allah's complete perfection.

MY USTAAD SAYS:

All praise is for Allah. Sometimes, when we see a good quality in someone, we

praise that person. This is a good thing to do.

When we praise a person, we should always remember that Allah is the One who gave that quality to that person. Without Allah's blessing, that person

could not have received that quality. When we remember this, the praise will actually be for Allah.

Allah listens to those who praise Him. When we begin Dua, we should always start by praising Allah. We should then

send Durood upon the Prophet ﷺ.

Then we should ask from Allah. This is the best way to make Dua.

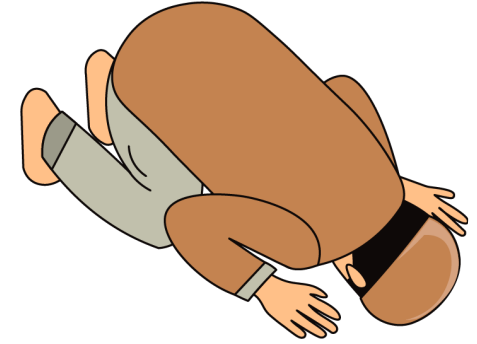

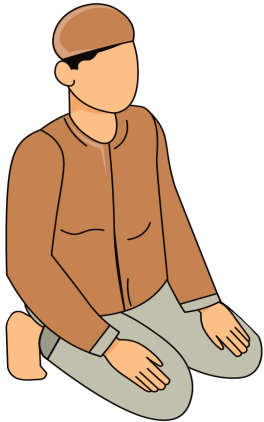

MAKING DUA

Making Dua after Salah

1 When making dua we should raise our hands to chest height. We should join our hands with the palms facing up.

2 We start dua by praising Allah and then sending Durud upon the prophet ﷺ.

3 Then we make dua for ourselves, our family, our community and all the Muslims. We should remember to ask Allah to fulfil our needs in the dunya and in the hereafter.

4 We finish dua by sending Durud upon the prophet and then wiping our hands over our face.

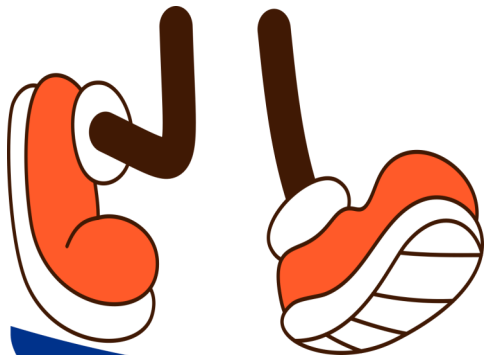

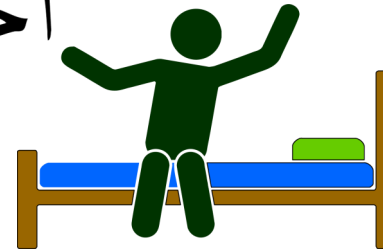

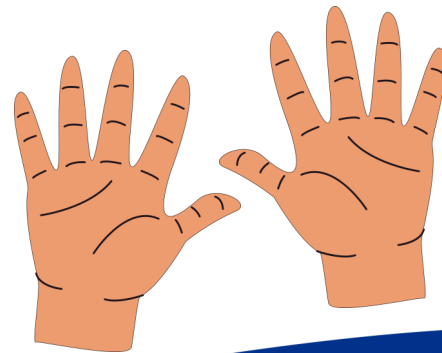
Ali ؓ and Fatima ؓ lived in Madina and had been married for a short time. Life was not easy for the new couple.

when one performs ablution, the second is untied;



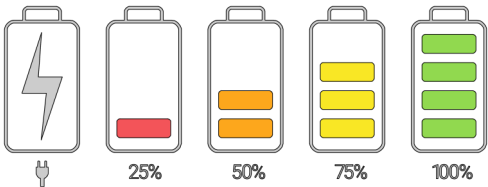
and when one prays, the third is untied;

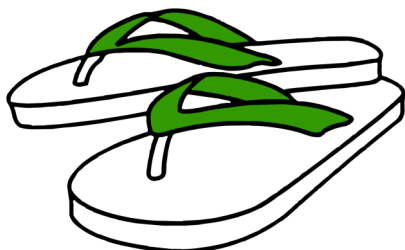

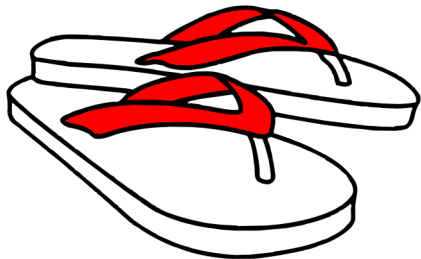

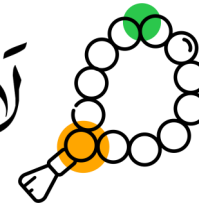

5. We then wipe our hands on our face.

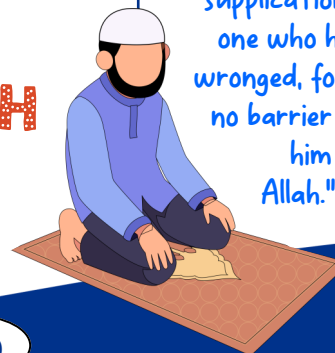
We do the Tasbeeh Fatimi which is

Allah's Messenger ﷺ said: "Faith has seventy-odd branches, and modesty (al-haya') is a branch of faith." (Muslim)

We should wear the amount needed to cover one's nakedness (awra) and protect the body from the heat and the cold.

The nakedness of a man is from the above the navel to the bottom of the knees.



The nakedness of a woman in front of ghair mehrams and non Muslim women is all of her body except her face, hands and feet.

Here are a few things you should consider:

Men should not hang their clothes below their ankles without a valid excuse.

Women's clothes should cover the top of their feet.



Clothes should not have pictures of living things.

Clothing should not resemble the clothing of other faiths.

Clothing should not be tight or see through.

Clothing should not resemble the opposite gender.

It is disliked for men to wear red (except headgear.)

It is disliked to wear one shoe, one sock etc. Instead either both feet should be covered or exposed. Likewise both hands should be covered or exposed.

Men are prohibited from wearing items made from pure silk.

Pig leather is prohibited.

The only jewellery men can wear is a silver ring which does not exceed 5g in weight.

The ring may have a stone.



Women can wear all forms of jewellery.

Allah's Messenger ﷺ said: "Verily, Allah does not look at your bodies nor your appearance, but rather He looks at your hearts and your deeds." Muslim

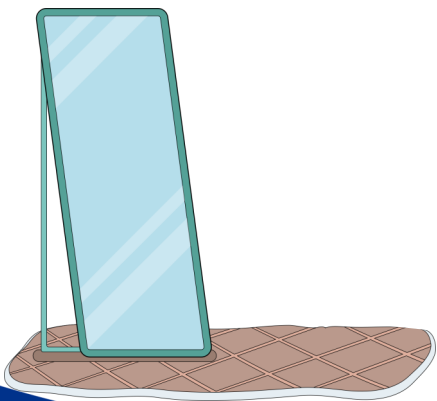

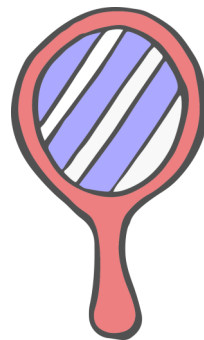

Prophet Muhammad ﷺ said, *"..Whoever turns away from my Sunnah is not of me."* Bukhari

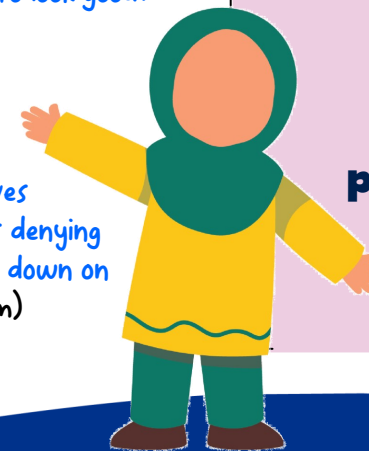

5. Drink in 3 breaths removing the cup from the mouth after each sip.

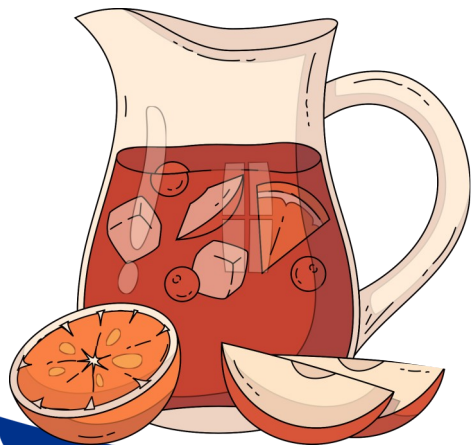


6. Do not drink directly from the jug or bottle. Pour the contents into a glass first and then drink.

SAYING THE SALAAM

My friend Jack also joined us, and he sometimes said salaam to us. We like hanging out together.

He knows a lot about Islam as well but isn't a Muslim. Maybe one day Jack will be a Muslim, inshaAllah.



MY USTAAD SAYS:

These are a few things to think about when we say salaam.

Greeting someone with Salaam is Sunnah. Making sure that the person hears it is recommended. Replying to the Salaam is obligatory. You must ensure that the person hears the reply.



The reply should be immediate without delay.

You should say Salaam when you meet and when you leave. If you meet someone several times in a day, or if a tree, wall or anything else comes between you then you should repeat the Salaam.

If someone tells you to convey their Salaam to another person, and you agree, it becomes Wajib to convey the Salaam to the other person.

If someone conveys Salaam to you from someone else you should reply **"Wa alayka wa alayhis salaam."**



If someone says Salaam to you in writing (letter or email etc.), you must respond either verbally or in writing.

If a group is addressed with Salaam it suffices if at least one person from the group responds.

If you enter an empty house you should say **"Assalamu alayna wa ala ibadihis saliheen."** The angels will respond to your Salaam.

If a non-muslim greets you with Salaam you should only respond with, **"Wa alaykum"**



I didn't want Abdullah to bore you with his boring friends!

MY USTAAD SAYS:

It is from the rights of a Muslim that people visit him when he is sick.

Good health is a blessing from Allah; we should use it whilst we have it. Sometimes, we need to be reminded of this fact because we take it for granted. The dunya is good at making us forget about this.



When we visit them, we should make dua for the person and show them kindness

HADITH GEMS

The Prophet ﷺ said: "Do not regard any act of kindness as insignificant, even meeting your brother with a cheerful countenance." (Muslim)

The Prophet ﷺ said: "There are two blessings in which most people are in great loss: good health and free time." (Bukhari)

The Prophet ﷺ said, "No Muslim visits a Muslim in the morning without a thousand angels praying blessing on him until evening, or visits him in the evening without a thousand angels praying blessing on him until morning and he will have fruits in the Garden." Hadith



My dad wants to visit his friend on the way home. He didn't come to work and is very poorly.

My dad said that it's sunnah to visit the sick and we should always practice the sunnah.

VISITING THE SICK

When we met my dad's friend, he looked very sick. He was lying on his sofa; his face was as red as a beetroot.

He was very unwell. My dad was sad, but he spoke with him in a kind and gentle way. My dad's friend was happy after that.

We didn't stay long.



MY USTAAD SAID

It is Sunnah to visit one day and then stay away for one or two days for fear of burdening the sick person if one visits more frequently, unless the sick person needs one's services, in which case one visits as needed.

We should care enough about each other to know if they are well or need help.

We should consider these Adaab.

To sit by the knee and look at the face and not be distracted from the diseased by looking around..

To not frown; rather, to be easy going and joyful.

To not talk to him except about what he finds wonderous.

To encourage positive feelings by speaking to him of a long life and a quick return to health.

To ask the sick person to pray for one.



To be very brief in one's visit.

HADITH GEMS

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "The believers in their mutual kindness, compassion and sympathy are just like one body. When one of the limbs suffers, the whole body responds to it with wakefulness and fever." (Bukhari and Muslim)

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "Whoever among you wakes up in the morning and is safe in his home, in good health and has enough provision for the day, it is as if he has all the good things of this world." (Tirmidhi)

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "Look at the one who is at a lower level than you, and do not look at the one who is above you, for that may keep you from scorning the blessing of Allah." (Muslim)

When I saw my dad's friend, I remembered when I was ill. It was such a tough time. I was glad when my friends visited.

I also realised that good health is such a great blessing from Allah. I was grateful to Allah.

So many people have worse health problems than me.

When we go to the House of Allah (the Masjid) we are the guests of Allah. This is why we ask Allah to open the doors of his mercy for us.

The first thing you must remember is that this is the house of Allah. We need to be respectful and show respect.

The second thing you must remember is that it's an honour for you that Allah has chosen you to enter the masjid. There are so many people who have been deprived of this privilege.

Always treat the masjid with love, care, honour and respect. You may

think it's just another building but masajid are the most honoured places on earth.

HADITH GEMS

Our Prophet ﷺ said, "The most beloved of places to Allah are the masajid and the most hated of places to Allah are the markets." (Sahih Muslim)

The streets were still busy, and we were already getting late.

My mum navigated expertly through the streets towards the masjid. She pulled up right outside the masjid. We got out and entered the masjid.

I thought we might get late, but not with Mum at the wheel.

MY USTAAD SAYS:

When we meet people with a smile it also makes that person feel good. In return that person is likely to be more nice to us. This is why smiling is such a powerful sunnah of the Prophet ﷺ.

Abdullah bin Al-Mubarak explained good character, and then he said: "It is a smiling face, doing one's best in good, and refraining from harm."

Tirmidhi

The Prophet ﷺ said, "Facilitate things to people (concerning religious matters), and do not make it hard for them and give them good tidings and do not make them run away (from Islam)." Bukhari

He had a big smile on his face, he seemed extra happy for some reason.

I know it's sunnah to smile, but I think it was because the madrassah test was going to be hard.

This includes when we do wudhu. We need to be thorough and not miss anything out.

If we don't do the fard actions properly, then the wudhu is not done!

My advice is to do all things to the best of your abilities and take things like this very seriously.

HADITH GEMS

The Prophet ﷺ Said, "He who performs the wudhu perfectly (according to Sunnah), his sins will depart from his body, even from under his nails." (Muslim)



I usually do wudhu at home, but I just never got the chance today.

I strategically placed myself so I was next in line for wudhu.

I sat down, said the dua and started my wudhu.

I was extra careful not to waste water or splash anyone.

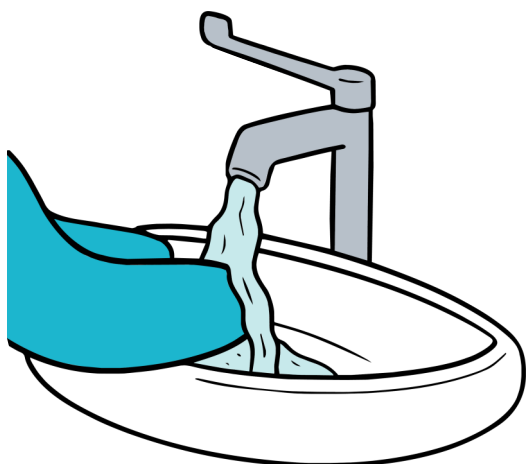

The Prophet ﷺ Said, "Were it not that it would be too difficult for my ummah, I would have instructed

them to do wudhu for every prayer and to use the siwak when doing wudhu." (an-Nasai)

MY USTAAD SAYS:

Don't waste water: Prophet Muhammad ﷺ would use a small container of water to do wudhu (holding one mudd = 775ml).

40. DUA AFTER WUDHU...

When we are saying the shahadah after wudhu we should point up at the sky with our shahadah finger. We stop pointing for the rest of the dua.

I quickly dried myself with one paper towel. I don't like to waste anything in the masjid.

It is an amanah and blessing from Allah.

After wudhu, my ustad taught us to always say these duas.

After I read the meanings I love this dua more!

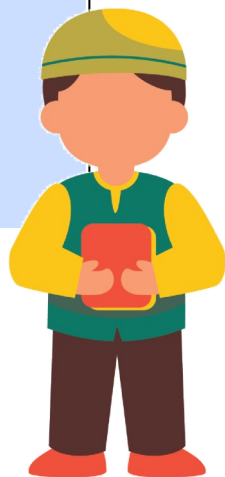

PROCESS OF GHUSL



- ✘ Have intention of washing to become pure.
- ✘ Wash your hands thoroughly.
- ✘ Wash your private areas and remove any impurities.
- ✘ Gargle water in your mouth (it must reach the back of throat)
- ✘ sniff water into nose then out (water reaches soft bone)
- ✘ Wash whole body properly (nothing must be left dry) - 3x

THE 3 FARA'IDH OF GHUSL

- ✘ Sniff water into the nose so it reaches the soft bone of the nose.
- ✘ Gargle so that water reaches the back of the mouth.
- ✘ Wash the whole body so not even one tiny part is left dry.

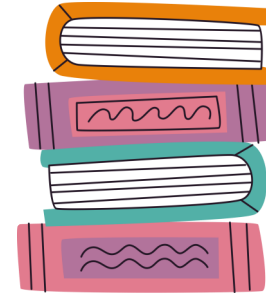

"Seeking knowledge is a duty upon every Muslim." (ibn Majah)

He reminded us that we should be good students, make our dua, and avoid all evil and bad things.

These all affect our hearts, and we want our hearts to be pure.

Gaining sacred knowledge is an honour, he takes it very seriously.

INCREASING KNOWLEDGE

My Ustaad wants me to teach at the madrassah when I am older.

He said I can also be an engineer, hafiz, teacher and so much more at the same time!

TRUST

Put your trust completely in Allah (Tawakkul). Then leave it with Allah. Allah only wants good for the believers.

Put lots of effort into your actions. Go back to the top and repeat.

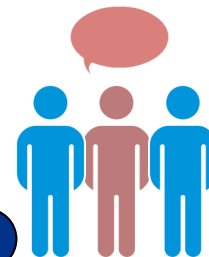

The Messenger of Allah ﷺ said, "If you are three, then two should not converse privately with the exclusion of the third..." (Bukhari)

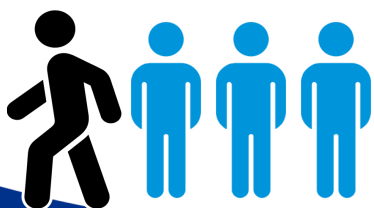

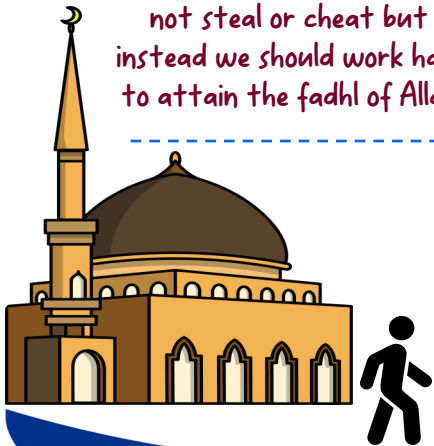

3. Do not talk in the Masjid.
4. Do not walk in front of those performing salah.
5. Keep the Masjid clean and don't bring dirt into the Masjid.

6. Do not quarrel and discuss worldly affairs.
7. Keep your voices moderate and switch off your phone.
8. Occupy your heart with the remembrance of Allah.
9. Show respect to Masjid and all things connected to Allah.



HADITH GEMS

the masjid, and the most hated places to Allah are the markets." (Muslim)

We should give the guests preferential treatment. Their children should also be treated well and allowed to play with and share the toys.



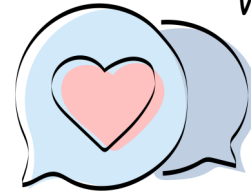
The food should be prepared carefully, even if it's better or more varied than the host would normally make.

We should also perform our Isha and Fajr Salah in Jamaat. When we perform Isha Salah and Fajr Salah in Jamaat, we get the reward of

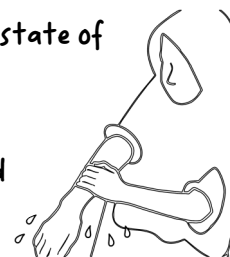
worshipping Allah all night.

4. To brush the teeth with a miswak.

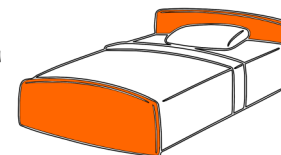


5. To sleep on the right hand side.

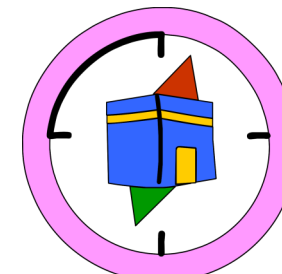
6. To sleep with the right palm under the right cheek and the knees slightly bent.
